

Community forum: Race, Class and Media Justice

In Seattle, **Reclaim the Media** holds monthly public forums designed to stimulate community conversations on a variety of issues involving media and democracy. Our October 2005 forum focused on issues brought up by media coverage of hurricane Katrina and its aftermath. Participants discussed racism and class oppression in media, the importance of ethnic and community media, and ways media can be used as tools for resisting institutionalized oppression.
